HardieDeck™ is designed to stay strong as it ages. Unlike timber, HardieDeck™ is resistant to damage from moisture and termites. And when the sun beats down, you can rely on HardieDeck™ not to warp or splinter.

SAFE FOR BUSHFIRE ZONES, FIRE PITS AND BARBEQUES.

Timber and traditional composite decks don't stand up to the risk of fire from BBQs, fire pits and bushfires.

HardieDeck™ is deemed non-combustible and can be used in all Bushfire Attack Level (BAL) zones, even Flame Zone (FZ) due to the uniquely designed FZ Top Strip that covers gaps and prevents ember attack.

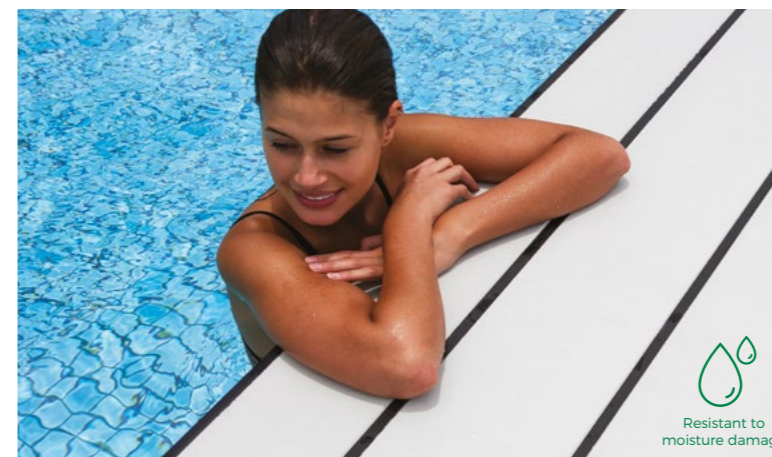


A DURABLE LOW TO GROUND DECK SOLUTION*.

With adequate cross-flow ventilation HardieDeck can be used as low as 150mm from the ground with its new concealed fixing system that integrates drainage and improves ventilation.

With concealed screws and solid, splinter-free boards, HardieDeck™ feels smooth and safe under bare feet. Walk, play and run with no sign of bounce, squeaks or sponginess.

Pools and spas can be punishing on decks. Repeated cycles of baking hot sun and soaking from pool water makes them vulnerable to rot and fading. Just the type of damage HardieDeck™ is designed to resist.

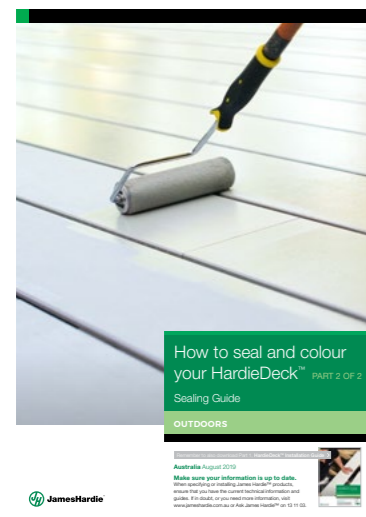
How it Works

James Hardie's fibre cement contains wood fibres. Similar to timber, it can be cut with a circular saw, but with a fibre cement blade*. It also contains cement, so it's resistant to damage from moisture, heat and sun making it a durable decking solution. HardieDeck™ boards are installed with a base jointer and top-strip system that conceals screws. Before the top strip goes on, it needs to be sealed with a clear or coloured sealer or durable paving paint.

However, most choose a contemporary shade of grey. It's important to seal HardieDeck properly for a lasting finish.

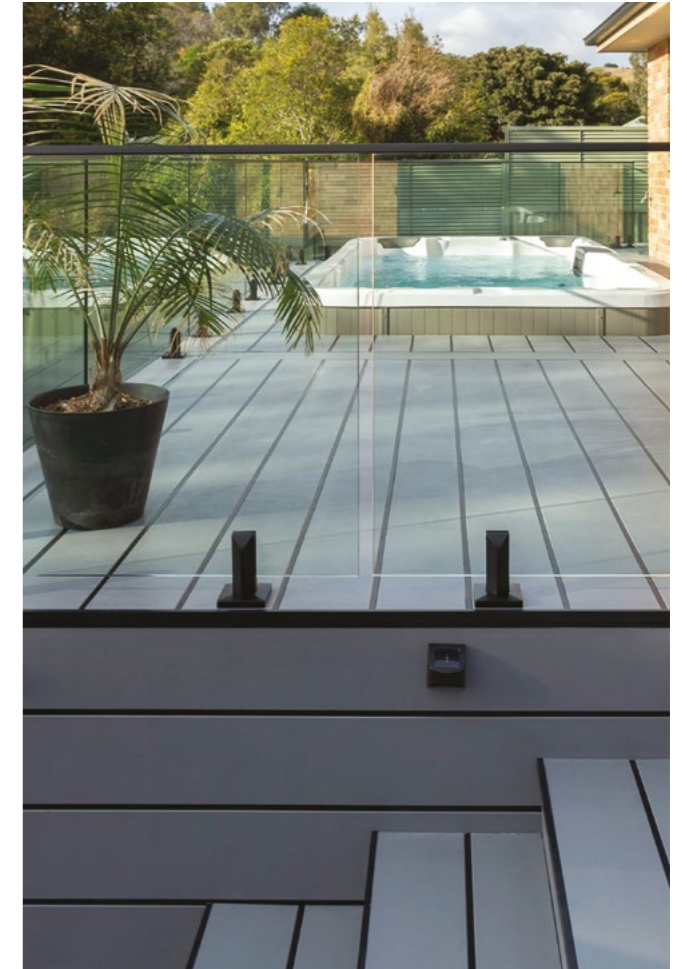

The owners of an older brick home decided to transform their small sloping backyard in Albion Park, NSW into an inviting outdoor room with spa.

The builder, David Mulhern from Mulbuild, steered his clients towards HardieDeck. "With the spa being part of the new area, you need a surface that's not going to rot, split or warp with exposure to water" David said. "Compared, with timber HardieDeck is much less responsive when it gets wet and dries out. Changing conditions can really ruin timber boards and other decking products. We ended up saving on labour, because installation is much easier and quicker." says Dave.
